



POSITION ANNOUNCEMENT

Position Title: Facilities Specialist
Location: San Diego, CA (Mission Bay)
Salary: \$13-16/hr, plus full benefits

Job Summary: Works under the general supervision of the Facility and Safety Manager. The Facilities Specialist performs a variety of semi-skilled and skilled tasks in the maintenance and operation of the Institute's corporate headquarters on Mission Bay in San Diego and occasionally at the Institute's aquaculture laboratory in Carlsbad. This position will be required to work a flexible schedule including some evenings, weekends, holidays, and occasional overtime. This position is also on call as required for security and maintenance after normal business hours.

Responsibilities/Job Duties include:

- Support the Facility Manager in the routine maintenance for all appropriate project equipment (e.g. pumps, blowers, chillers, boilers, freezers); seawater systems (e.g. heat exchangers, electronic valves, filters); and vehicles and vessels.
- Duties will include: janitorial, basic carpentry, electrical and plumbing, painting, sanding, general cleaning, and collection and delivery of water samples.
- Log temperature readings on several pieces of equipment.

Qualifications:

- Responsible and hardworking individual with the ability to work both independently and as part of a team.
- Specific duties and responsibilities include but are not limited to: basic skills in mechanical, electrical wiring, carpentry, and plumbing.
- Must possess valid California driving license with acceptable driving record for the past three years, and insurability to drive an HSWRI vehicle.

Physical Requirements and Working Conditions:

- Must possess the mobility to work in a building and outdoor setting, to use standard facility maintenance equipment and tools, and to use a computer.
- Must be physically fit, able to vertically lift at least 50 lbs and move 80 lbs., able to work on ladders, and able to swim sufficiently to save oneself.

TOOLS AND EQUIPMENT USED:

- Janitorial equipment including vacuums, mops, brooms, floor machines, landscape blowers and various hand and power tools used for building maintenance including and power lifts and fork lift vehicles and motor vehicles.
